

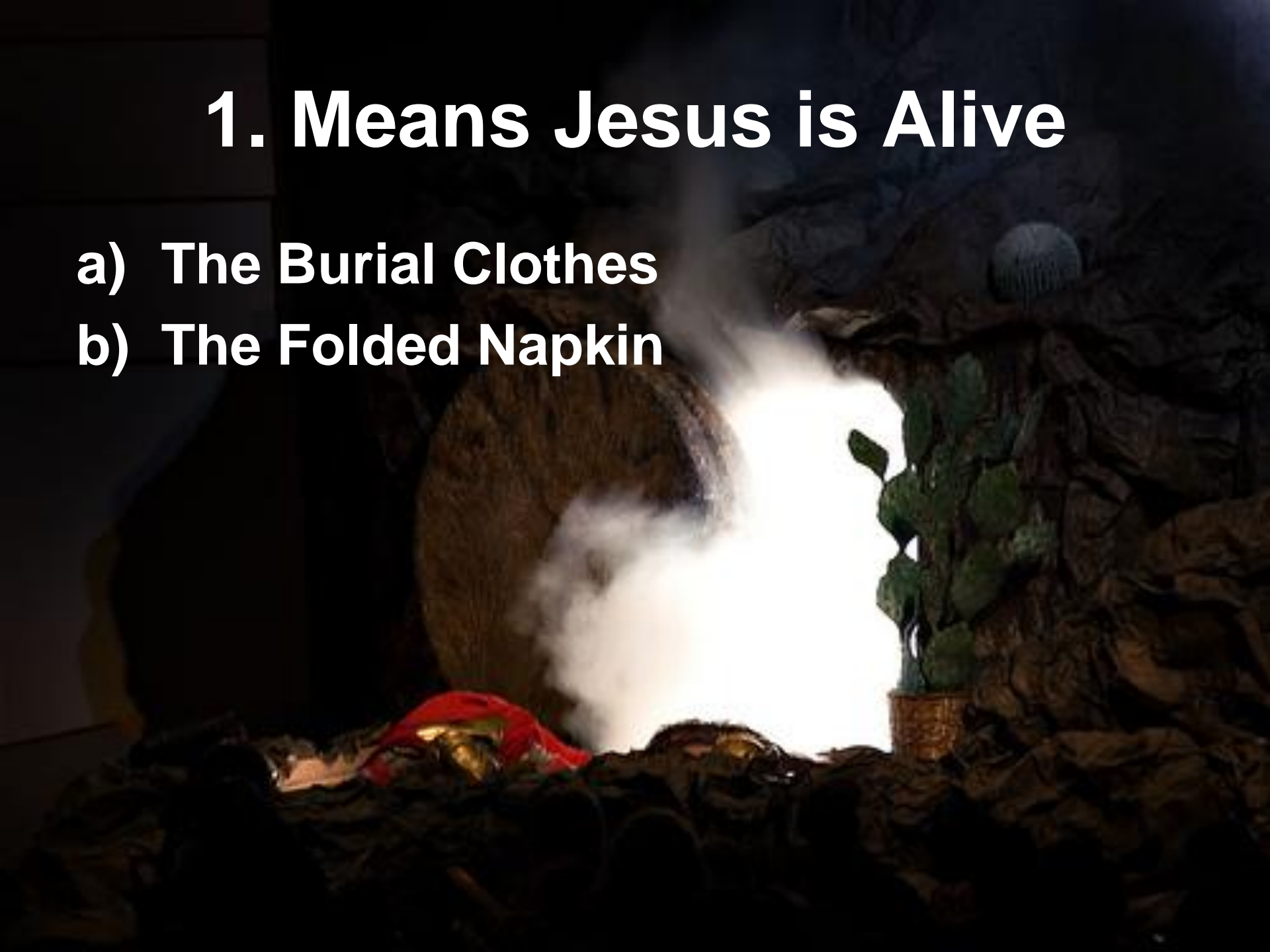
God Still Rolls Stones Away

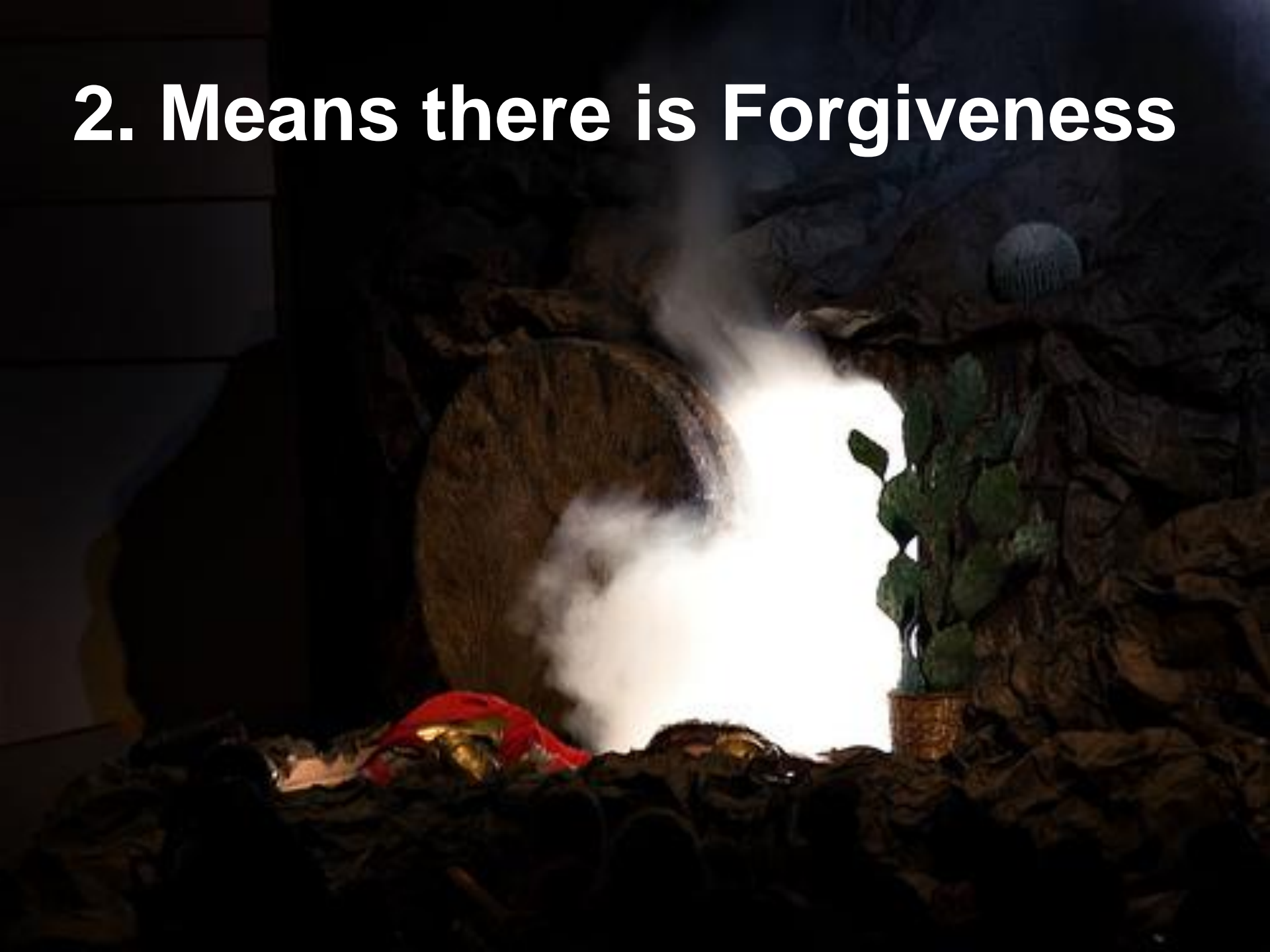

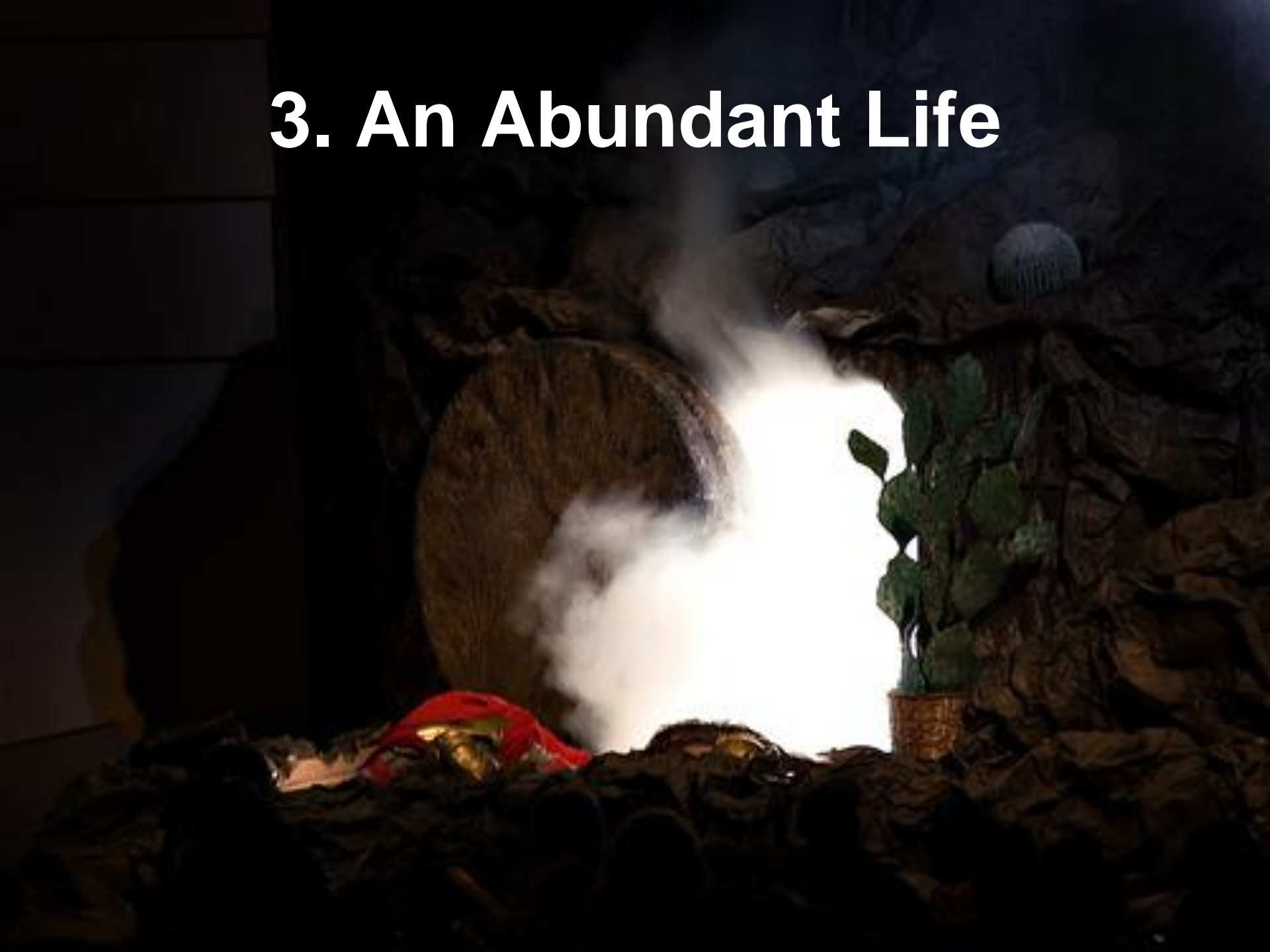
