Attitude of the prostitute:

Shows her love to Jesus because He forgave her many sins

She respects Him because of what He did for her

Therefore.... the prostitute represents Christians who:

Show respect

Have a high regard for those in authority

Understand very clearly that we are all sinners and that no one is perfect

Attitude of the Pharisee:

Does not greet Christ

Does not wash His feet

Does not anoint His head

Therefore...the Pharisee represents Christians who:

Disregard people of authority

Show no respect, nor has any social graces

Show a condemning eye to those who know that they have much sin in their life

The prostitute knows that she has been forgiven for many sins.

The Pharisee thinks that he does not have sins to be forgiven.

Am I going to act like a prostitute or a Pharisee?
