Matthew 9:35-10:29**

SIX COSTS OF FRONTIER MISSIONS

1. The cost of being arrested by authorities.

"Look, I'm sending you out like sheep among wolves..." (Matthew 10:16–18, HCSB)

2. The cost of family betrayal.

"Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child. Children will even rise up against their parents and have them put to death." (Matthew 10:21, HCSB)

3. The cost of being hated by everyone.

"You will be hated by everyone because of My name. But the one who endures to the end will be delivered." (Matthew 10:22, HCSB)

4. The cost of being persecuted and driven out of town.

"When they persecute you in one town, escape to another. For I assure you: You will not have covered the towns of Israel before the Son of Man comes." (Matthew 10:23, HCSB)

5. The cost of being maligned (trashed, criticized).

"...If they called the head of the house 'Beelzebul,' how much more the members of his household!" (Matthew 10:25, HCSB)

6. The cost of being killed.

"Don't fear those who kill the body but are not able to kill the soul; rather, fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." (Matthew 10:28, HCSB)
